Safety observation cards are an important tool. They allow the workforce to play their part by raising safety concerns and highlighting good practice, enabling operators and employers to act on them.

The Step Change in Safety electronic observation system (e-obs) overcomes many of the shortfalls seen in paper systems allowing:

- Direct feedback to those who have raised observations
- safety observation data to be easily accessed, shared and used effectively between operators and contractors
- high level data to be gathered and analysed to identify trends and target resources where they are needed most.

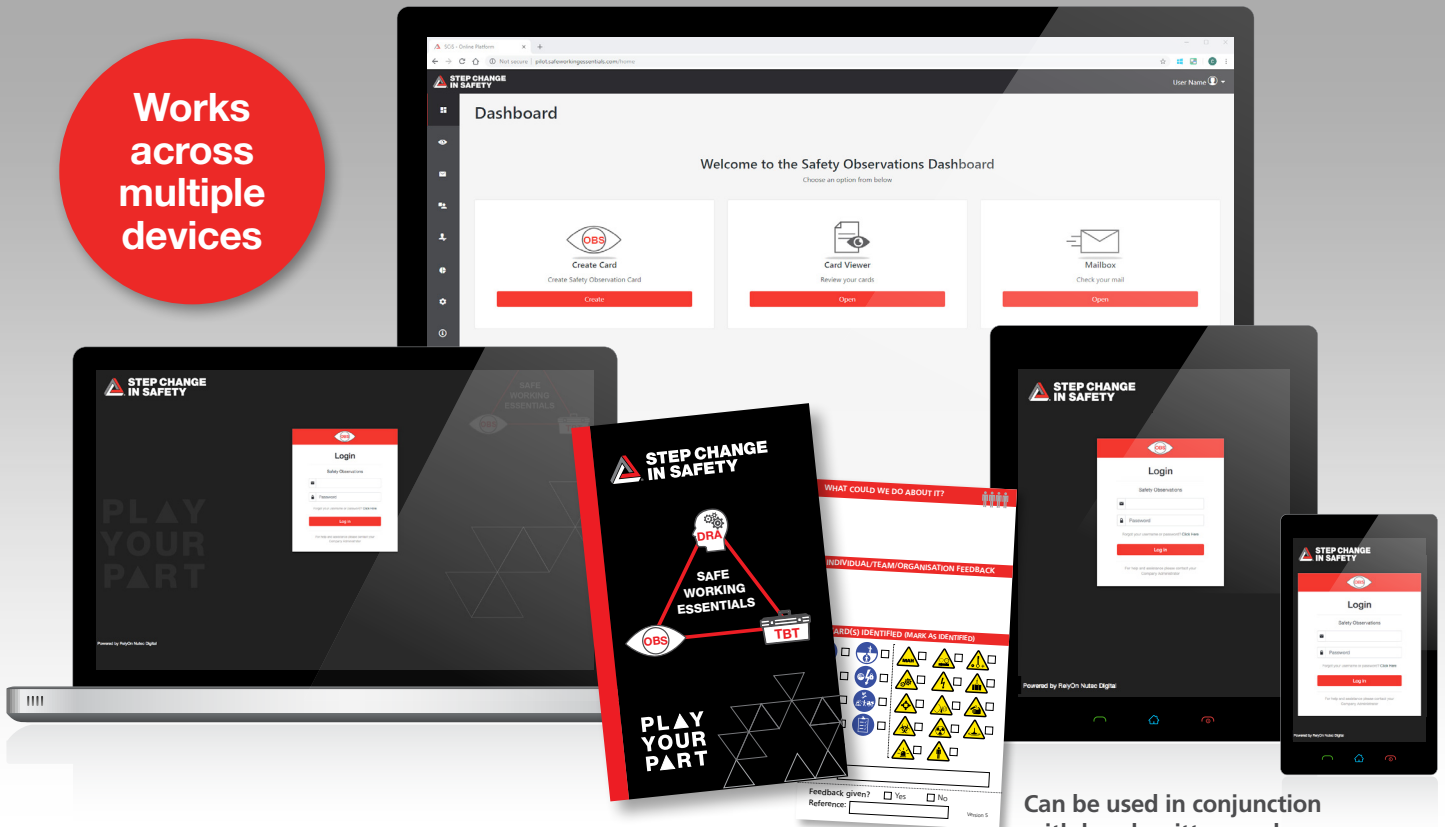

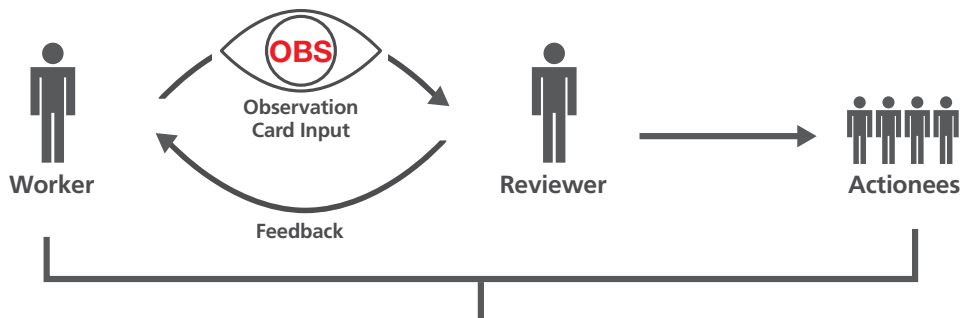
